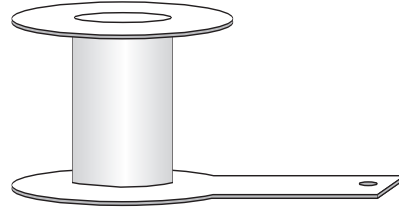

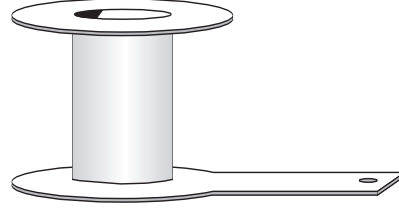

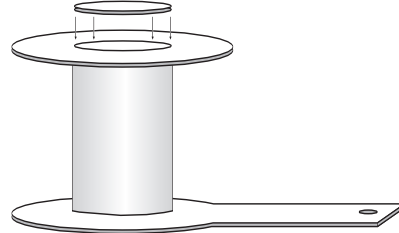
Standard (light weight)



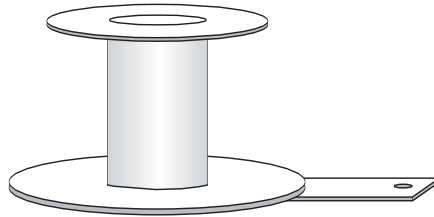
Weighted Hinge (medium weight)



Disc Adhered to Flapper Valve (heavy weight)

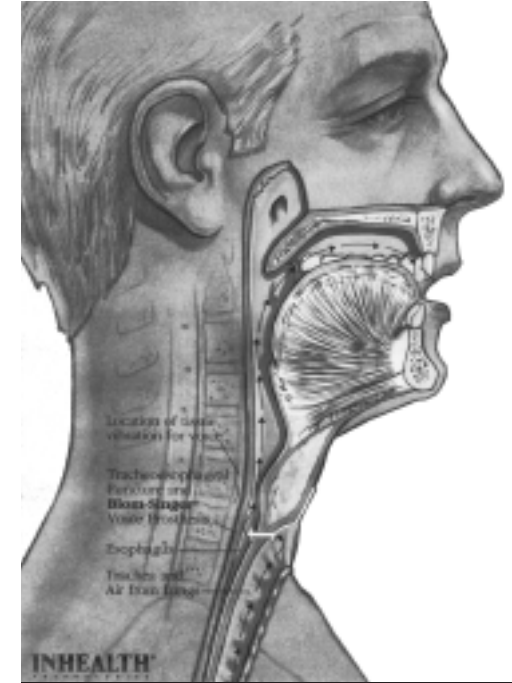


Increased Flange (tracheal flange)
